

# 90° Double Strip Ruler By Rachel Cross

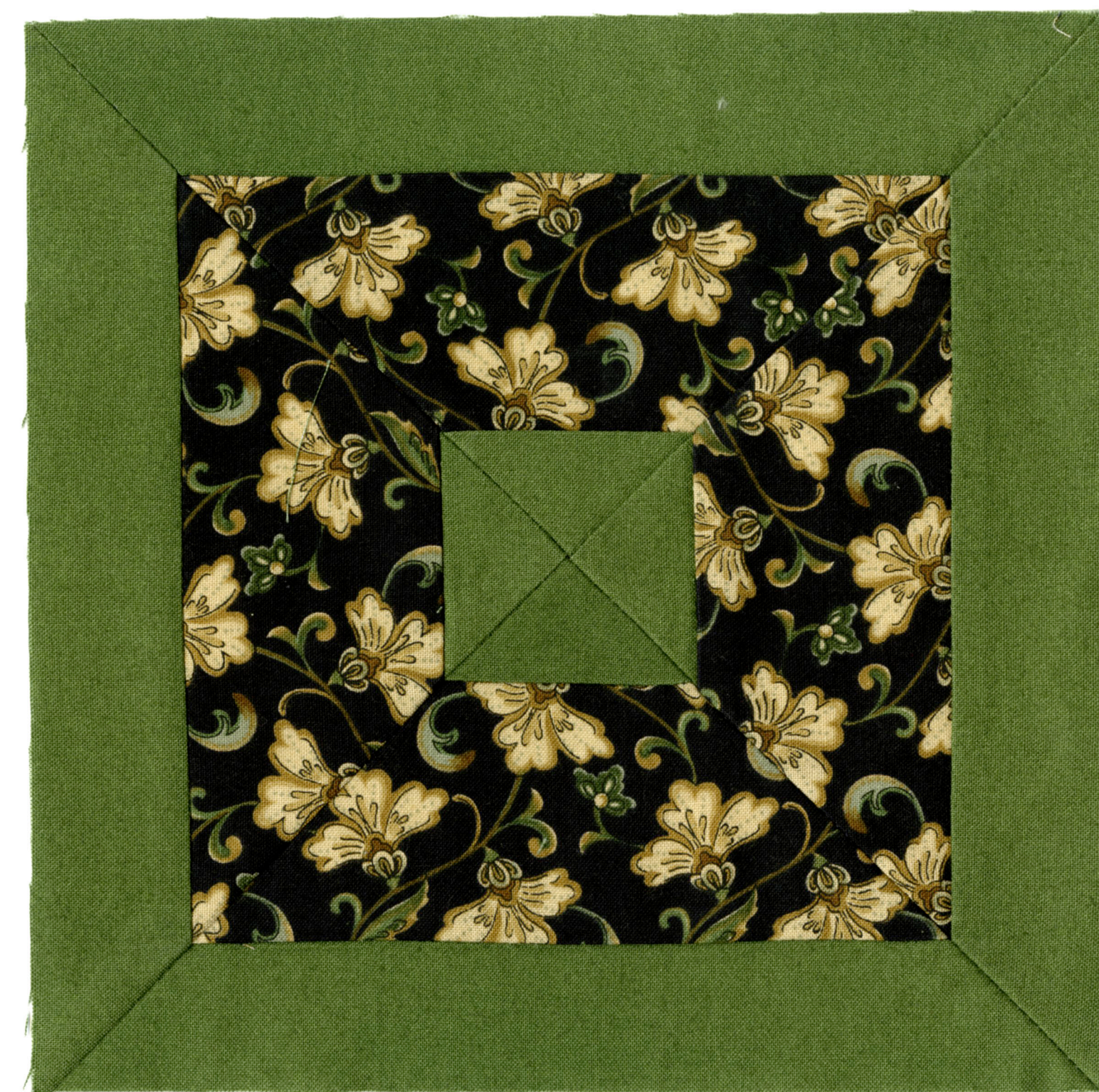
## Item #CGRDBS90



- 1** Cut two – 2 ½" strips from coordinating fabric with the straight edge of the ruler. Sew together two – 2 ½" strips. This strip set should measure 4 ½". Press the seams toward the dark fabric. Place the ruler over the strip set and cut the angled sides. Cut a total of four triangles - two of each colorway.



- 1A** Piece four triangles together to create an 8" finished square.



- 2A** Piece 4 triangles together to create an 8" finished square.



- 2** Sew a 1 ½" strip to each side of a coordinating 2 ½" strip to create a strip set. Press the seams in one direction so they will "nest" when sewing the triangles together. Place the ruler over this strip set and cut the angled sides. Cut a total of four triangles.

- 3** Sew four 1 ½" strips of coordinating fabrics together to create a strip set. Press the seams in one direction so they will "nest" when sewing the triangles together. Place the ruler over this strip set and cut the angled sides. Cut a total of four triangles - two of each colorway.



- 3A** Piece 4 triangles together to create an 8" finished square.



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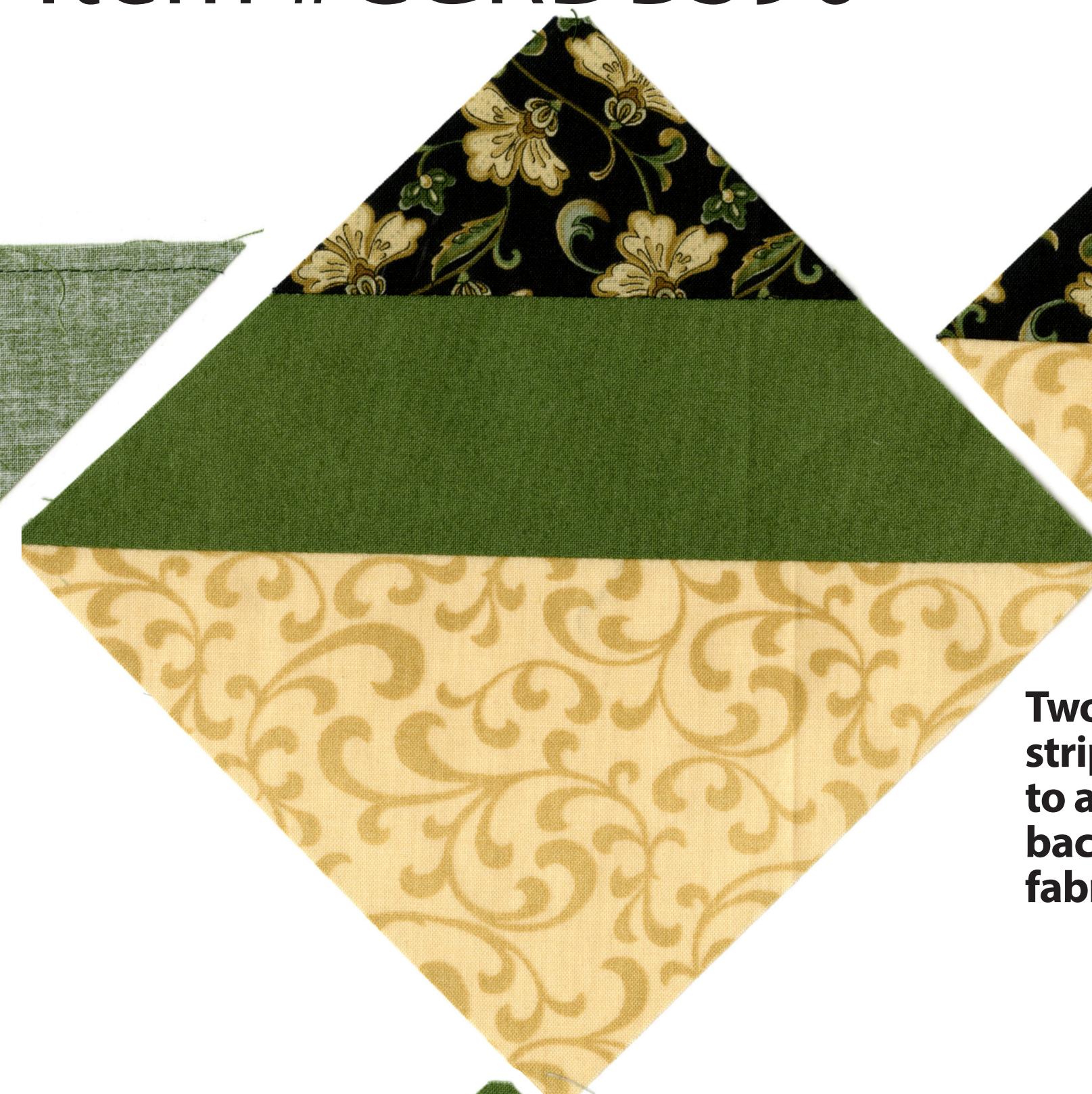
**1** Sew together any series of strips that measure 4 ½". Make a total of two sets. Sew these two strip sets together to form a tube. Place the blunt tip of the ruler on the top of the strip set tube and the base of the triangles on the bottom of the tube.

**1A** Cut on the angled sides and remove the few stitches at the tip to create squares. Open up the triangles and press. The outside edges of these squares are bias so ironing with Best Press is encouraged!



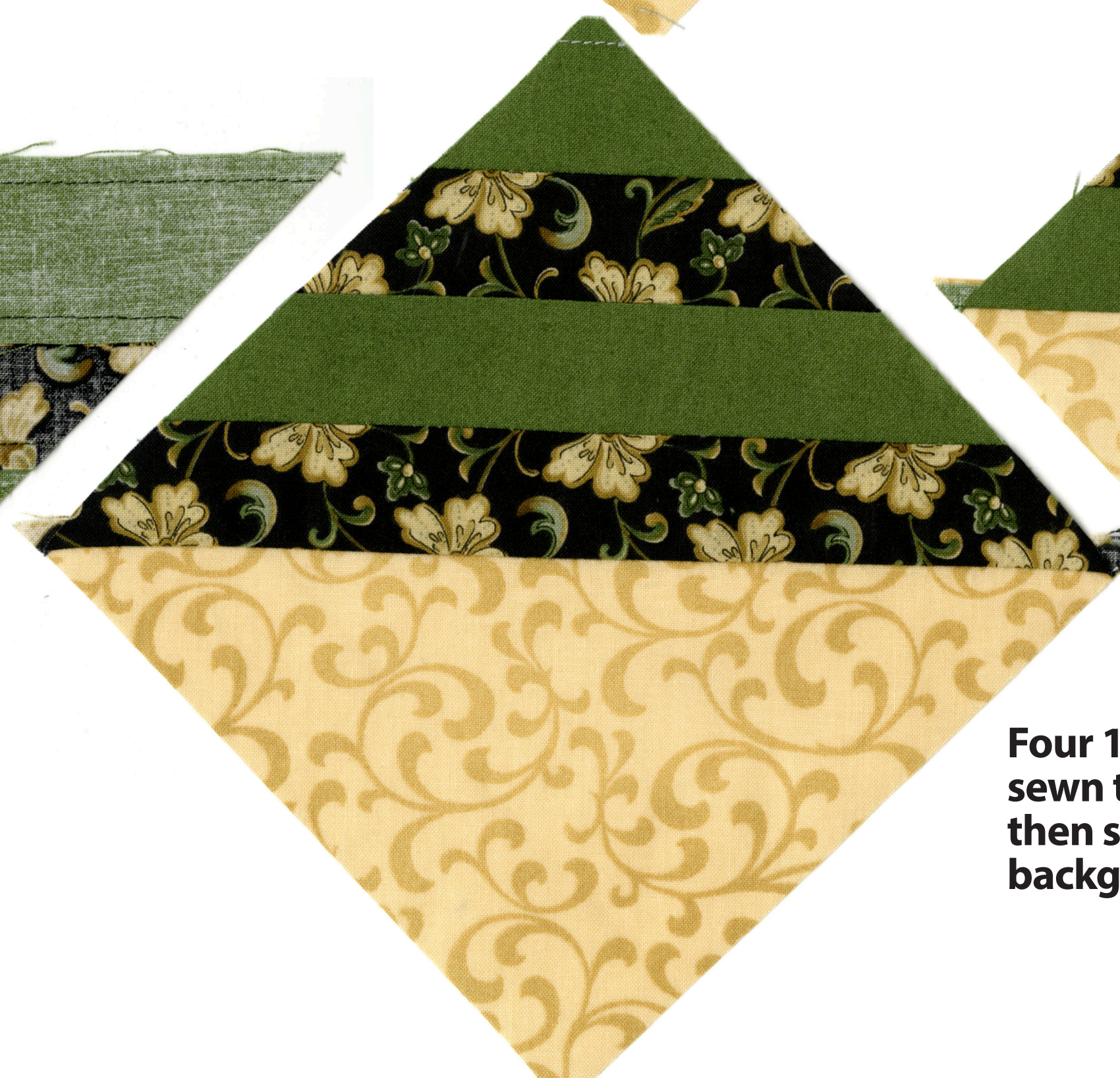
**2** Sew together any series of strips that measure 4 ½". Make a total of two sets. Sew these two strip sets together to form a tube. Place the blunt tip of the ruler on the top of the strip set tube and the base of the triangles on the bottom of the tube.

**2A** Cut on the angled sides and remove the few stitches at the tip to create squares. Open up the triangles and press. The outside edges of these squares are bias so ironing with Best Press is encouraged!

Two – 2 ½" strips sewn to a 4 ½" background fabric strip.



**2B**

Four 1 ½" strips sewn together and then sewn to a 4 ½" background strip.
