

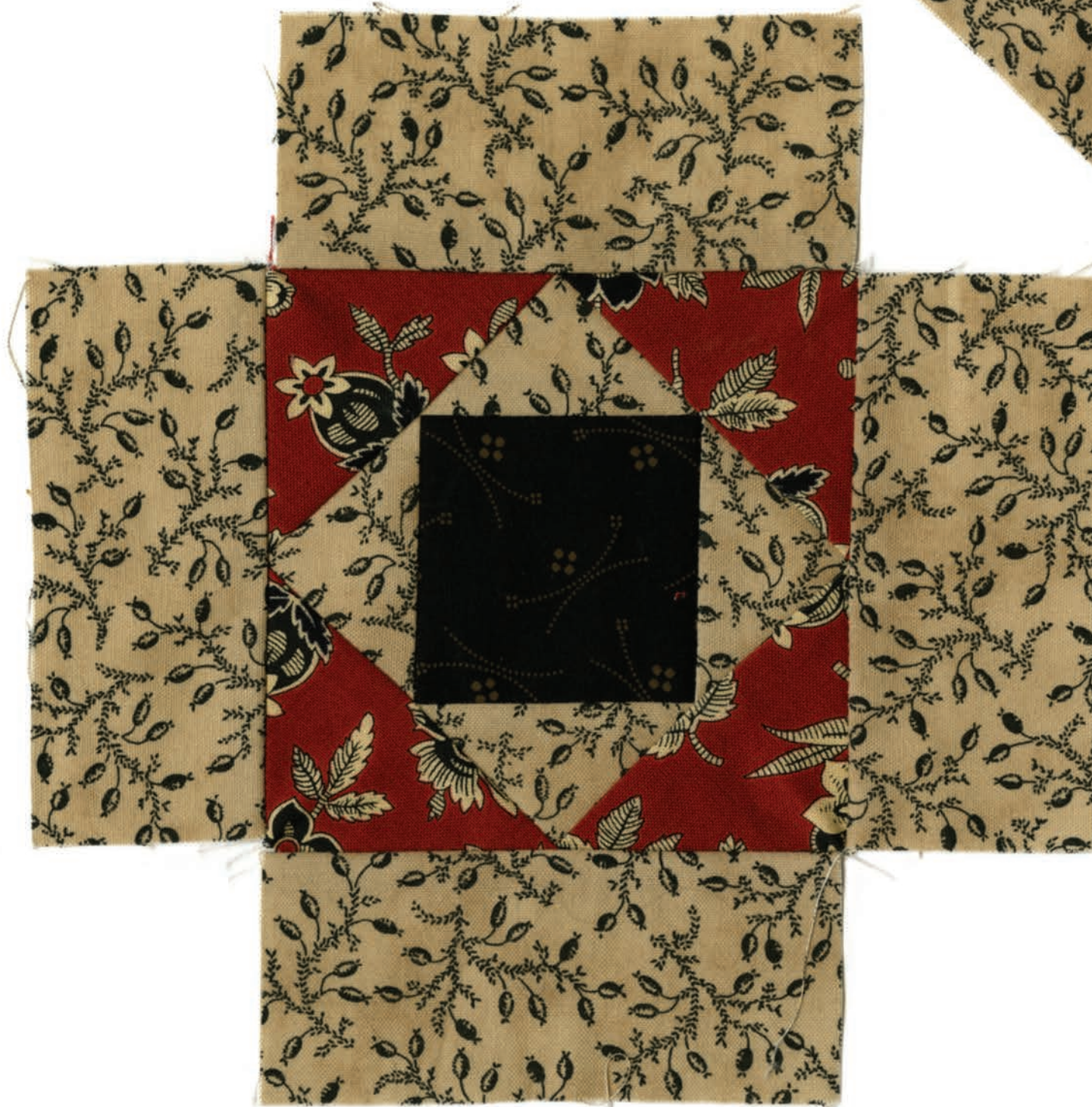
Pineapple Trim Tool Item #CGRJAW3



- 1** Cut a 2 1/2" center square; strips at least 1 5/8" wide; and four 2 1/2" x 4" rabbit ear corners.



Round #1 – Sew a strip to each side of the 2 1/2" square. Place the white square marked "Centering Square – Round #1" on the center square of the stitched unit. Trim all four sides.

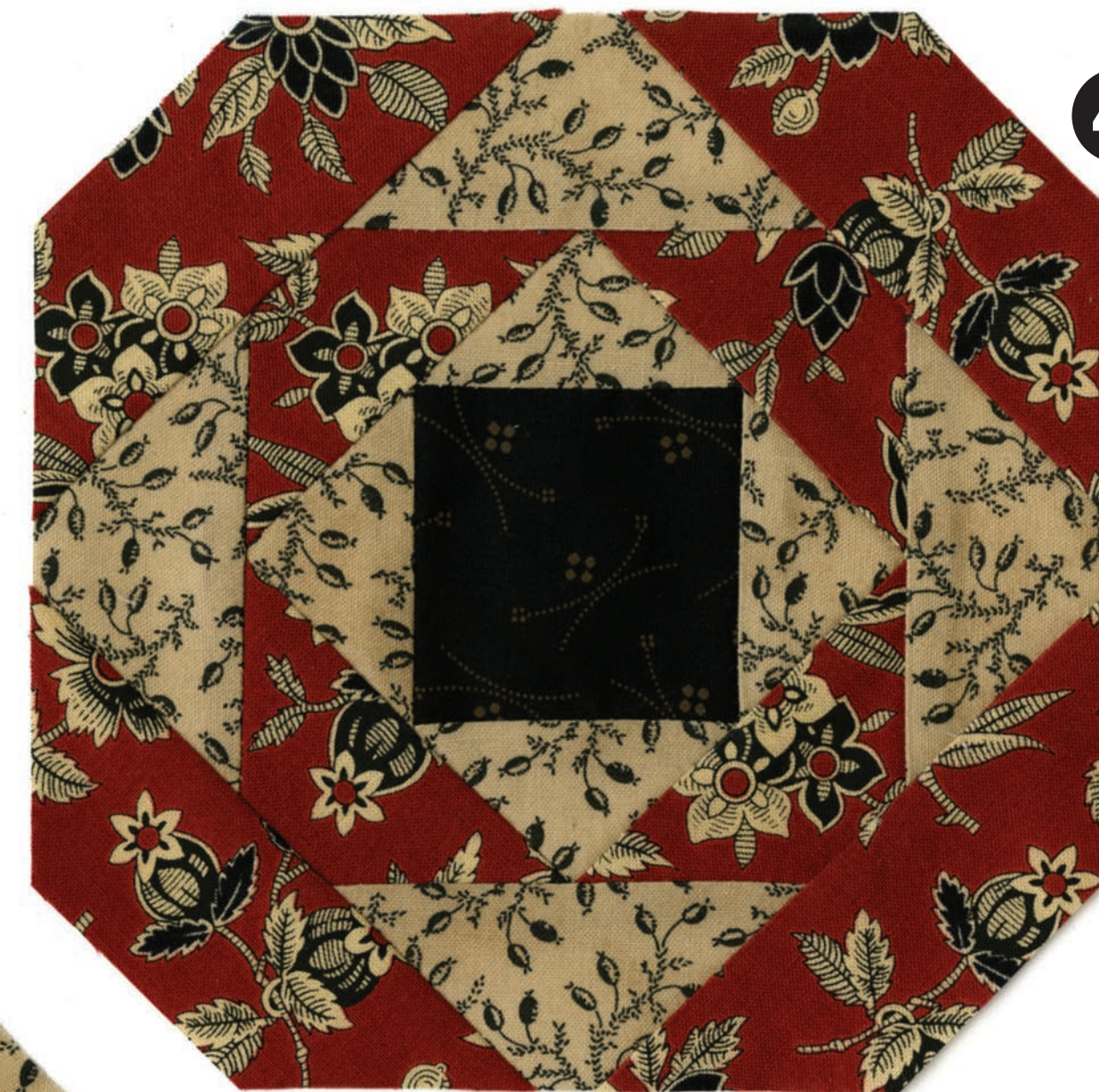


- 3** Round #3 – Sew a strip to each side of the block trimmed in Round #2. Place the 45° white angle line on the seam line of round #2. Trim all four sides.

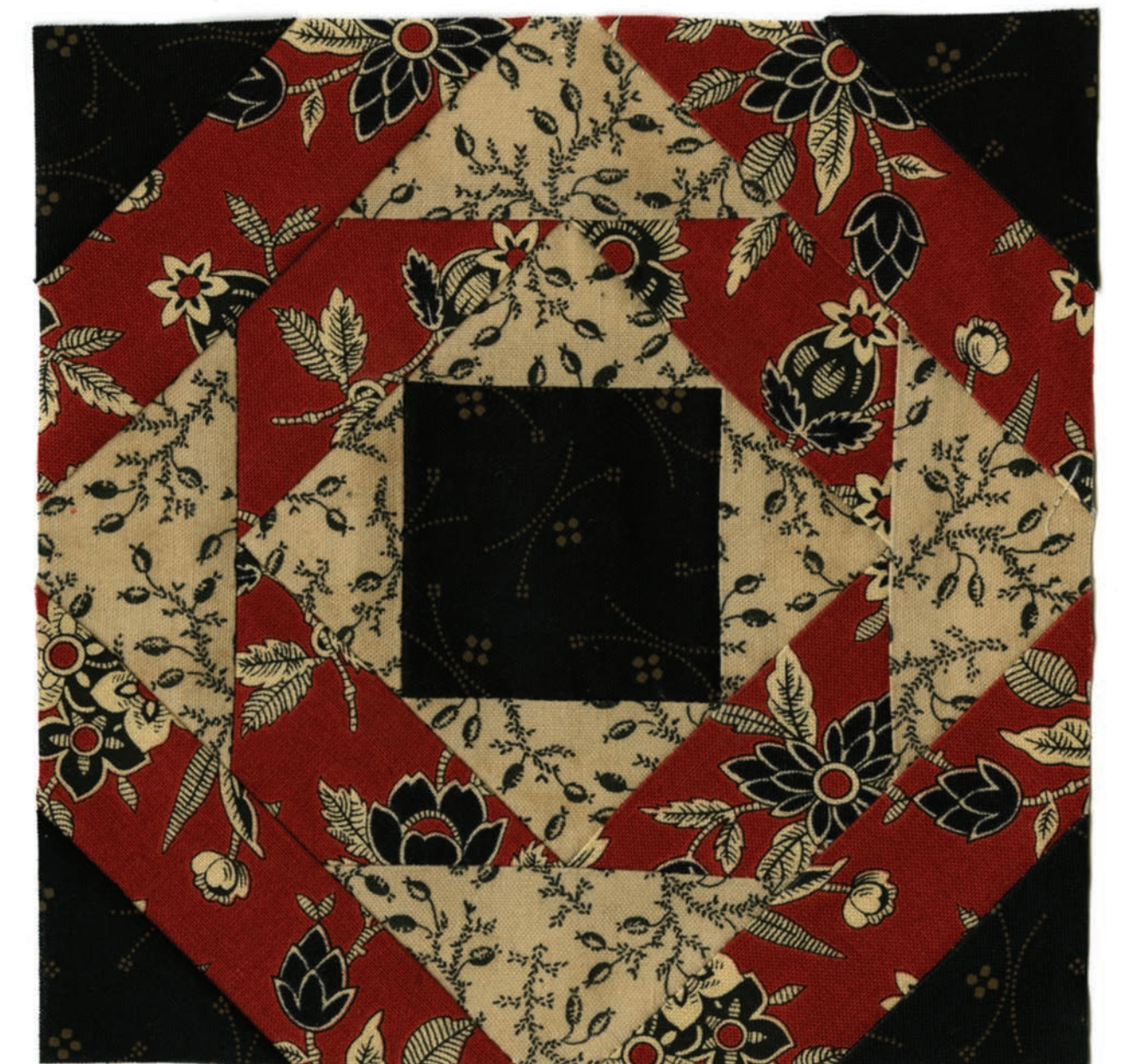


- 2** Round #2 – Sew a strip to each side of the block trimmed in Round #1. Place the black dashed square marked "Centering Square – Round #2" on the center square of the stitched unit. Trim two sides. Turn the stitched unit 180° and trim the remaining two sides.

- 4** Round #4 – Sew a strip to each side of the unit trimmed in Round #3. Place the black solid square marked "Centering Square – Round #4" on the center square of the stitched unit. Turn the stitched unit 180° & trim the remaining two sides. Then place the white angled line on the seam line of Round #4 and trim all four sides.

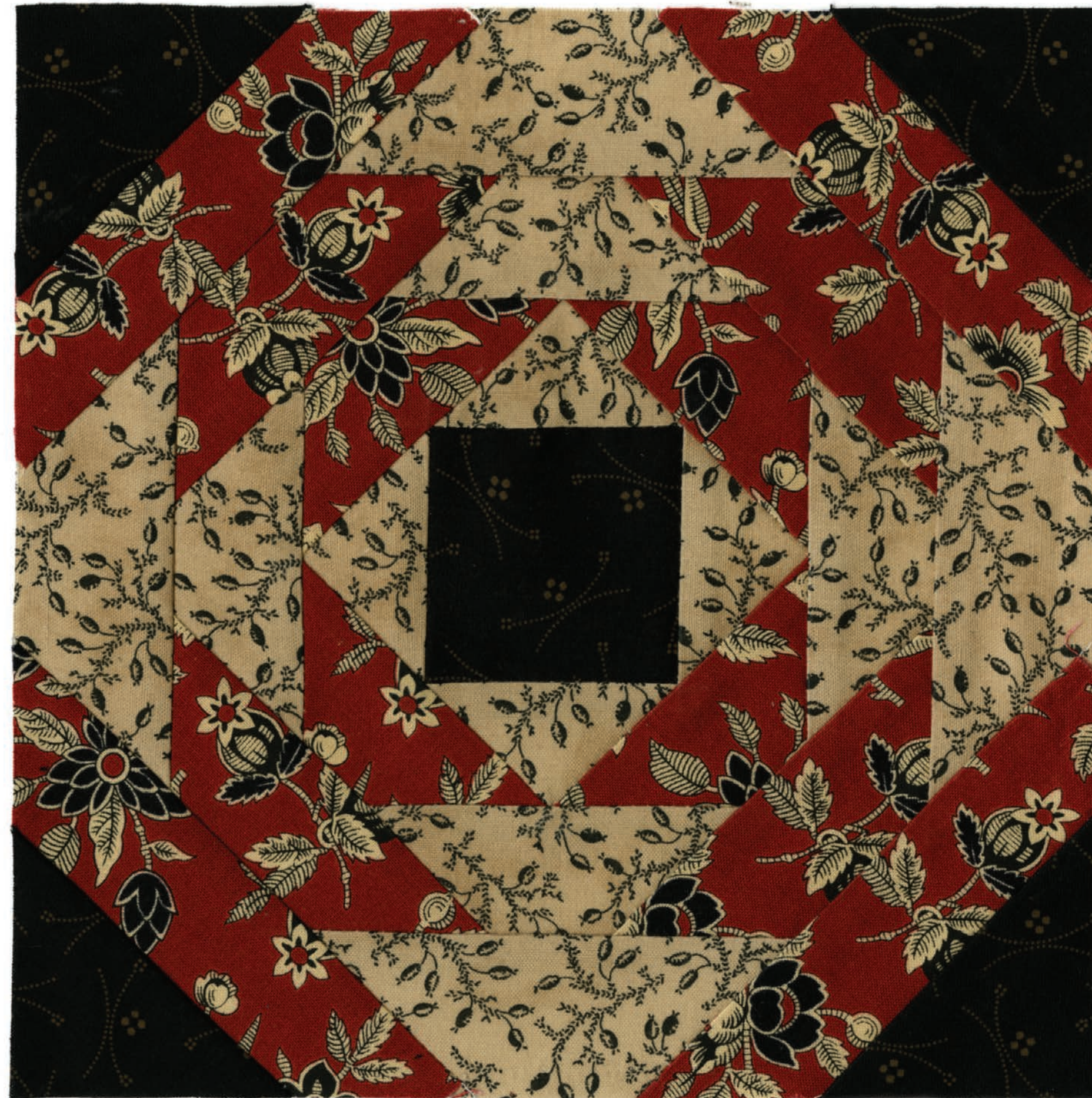


- 5** Completing the 6" Finished Pineapple Block: Sew a "rabbit ear unit" to the outside edge of strip #4. Place the black solid square marked "Centering Square – Round #4" on the center square of the stitched unit. Trim two sides. Turn the stitched unit 180° and trim the remaining two sides.
